Musician Adolph J. Weimerskirch

Adolph Weimerskirch entered the Army on September 19, 1917. He was attached to the 333rd Machine Gun Battalion at Camp Grant for 3 months. Then he was transferred to the 1st Army Headquarters at Camp Green as a bugler, where he also remained 3 months. In February, 1918, he was sent to France on the boat Antigone. In France he was a musician in the 6th Cavalry Band and was stationed at the following Army Headquarters: St. Nazaires, Tours-Selles, Gievres, Vendome. During his service in France he received a furlough to visit his folks and relations in Grosbous, Luxemburg. In June 1919 he returned to the U. S. A. on the steamer Kronland and was discharged from Camp Grant on the 10th of July, 1919. - Fausto 2008-04-04
