Adolph Weimerskirch entered the Array on September 19, 1917. He was attached to the 333rd Machine Gun Battalion at Camp Grant for 3 months. Then he was transferred to the 1st Army Headquarters at Camp Green as a bugler, where he also remained 3 months. In February, 1918, he was sent to France on the boat Antigone. In France he was a musician in the 6th Cavalry Band and was stationed at the following Army Headquarters: St. Nazaires, Tours-Selles, Gievres, Vendome. During his service in France he received a furlough to visit his folks and relations in Grosbous, Luxemburg. In June 1919 he returned to the U. S.
